Farm Facts

A farm is a piece of land used to grow crops and/or raise animals for produce.

People who grow this produce are called "farmers", and their work is called "farming".

Farms come in all shapes and sizes, with some being very large and others very small.

There are many types of farming, which we'll look at more closely. Some farms are run by people who eat the food they farm (subsistence agriculture), whilst other farms, usually large ones, sell their products to many people far away in urban areas (industrial farming).

Most subsistence farms exist in less wealthy countries, while industrial farms tend to be in wealthier countries.
